

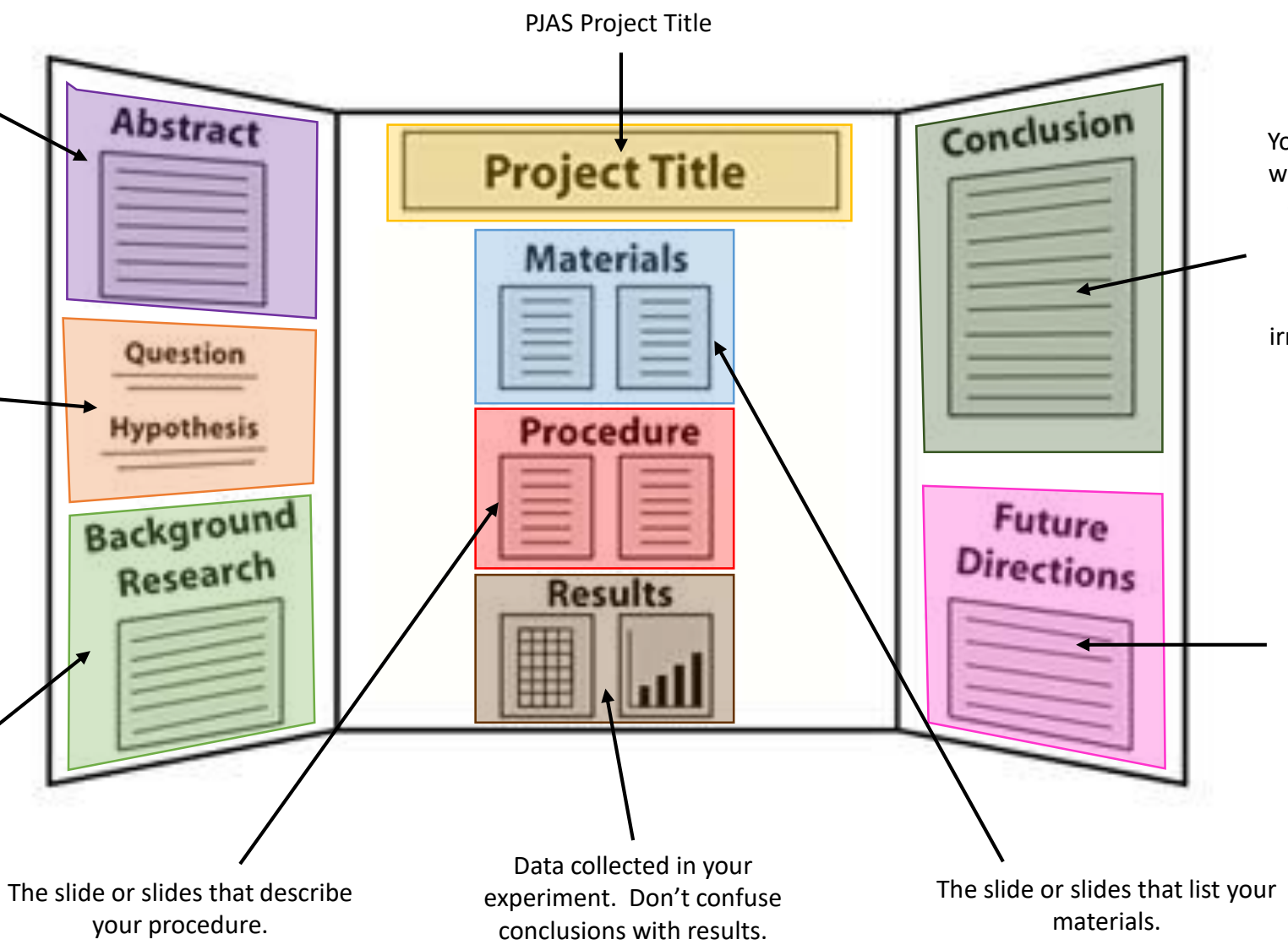
**Print PJAS slides. You may need to condense, or eliminate some slides to fit the space restricted by the poster board.**

**As necessary, feel free to print slides to full-, half-, or quarter-page. Please ensure that all text is readable at that size.**

You will most likely need to summarize your project. 1-2 sentences (each) describing why you did this project, what you did in this project and your conclusions.

If you've written a question to answer, simply include that. Otherwise, rephrase the reason for your research (purpose) as a question. Include your PJAS hypothesis.

Add all relevant slides that describe the research you did about the chemical/physical properties, biological facts, behavioral trends, etc, that helped you define your scientific procedure in this project. Include your list of sources/references.



Your slides in which you discuss whether or not your results are evidence for or against your hypothesis. Include any comments on your experimental method or irregularities as you carried out your experiment.

These are the ideas for furthering your research or improving your PJAS project that you would normally use to conclude your presentation.
